

**Rules of Play  
Chase the Ace  
Catholic Family Services of the Battlefords Inc.**

**i) Any employee of Catholic Family Services Inc. is not allowed to purchase Chase the Ace tickets.**

**Members of the organization or people involved in the conduct and management of the Chase the Ace raffle are not allowed to buy tickets. Immediate family are allowed to buy tickets.**

**ii) Chase the Ace players must be 19 years of age and older.**

**iii) All tickets are \$5 each.**

**Tickets may be purchased for each round of play at the Blend Restaurant & Bar 1602 – 100<sup>th</sup> Street North Battleford between 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. before the actual draw.**

**Volunteers or members of Catholic Family Service may sell tickets at other events or venues.**

**There is no limit on total tickets that may be purchased by an individual.**

**iv) Total number of tickets available for sale are 150,000.**

**v) Draws are every Thursday at 8:15 p.m. commencing date of Thursday Sept 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Concluding date of Thursday June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Excluding dates December 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020.**

**vi) Draws will be made at the Blend Restaurant & Bar 1602 – 100<sup>th</sup> Street North Battleford**

**vii) Chase the Ace**

**viii) Of total weekly ticket sales, 20% is awarded to the winning ticket holder on the day of the event. 30% is retained for the growing jackpot prize and 50% is awarded to Catholic Family Services of the Battlefords Inc.**

**If the winner draws the Ace of Spades they receive the jackpot plus the additional prize of a TV and TV stand worth \$2,700.00.**

**If the Ace of Spades is drawn in the first five events a new draw with a new deck will begin with the draw the following week and continue until the Ace of Spades is drawn or until June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Of total weekly ticket sales, 20% is awarded to the winning ticket holder on the**

day of the event. 30% is retained for the growing jackpot prize and 50% is awarded to Catholic Family Services of the Battlefords Inc.

If the winner draws the Ace of Spades they receive the jackpot.

**Play Out Plan:** In the event that the Ace of Spades is not drawn by the end of June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020, then the final draw will play out on June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020. If the initial lottery winner on June 11<sup>th</sup> does not draw the Ace of Spades, another ticket will be selected. The next winner or proxy will draw a card from the deck and if the Ace of Spades is not pulled another winner will be drawn for a chance to draw the ace until the ace is found. Only tickets sold this week will be eligible for the next draws.

If all tickets are sold during the game before the Ace of Spades is drawn, then the ticket winner or proxy will draw for the Ace. If not picked the draws will continue that evening until the Ace is drawn for the jackpot. Only tickets sold this week will be eligible for the draws.

ix) Any unclaimed prizes will be held for a period of one year from the date of the draw. If at that time any prize is still unclaimed the prize shall be donated to a charitable beneficiary approved by SLGA.

### **House Rules**

A new deck of standard 52 playing cards is used. The winning card is the Ace of Spades. Losing cards are defaced and removed from deck after each draw.

The lottery will continue with weekly draws until the earlier of 1) Ace of Spades is drawn or 2) All the tickets are sold or 3) The license expires on June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

A random ticket draw and the choosing of a card from deck will take place at the Blend Restaurant & Bar 1602 – 100<sup>th</sup> Street North Battleford SK every Thursday at 8:15 p.m. The winning ticket will be randomly chosen by a representative of CFS appointed by the Board of Directors. Prior to the draw, the cards will be flipped over to show that the Ace of Spades is indeed in the deck. The cards will then be shuffled and the winner or proxy allowed to choose a card. Following the draw, the cards will be securely stored, where they will remain until the next draw.

The Proxy appointed will be announced at each draw. The Proxy cannot be involved in the sale of tickets, the drawing of winning tickets, purchase tickets or play Chase the Ace that week.

**If the Ace of Spades is chosen at the first weekly round, 50% of total ticket sales from the round plus the starting Entertainment Unit worth \$2,700 (TV & Stand) will be awarded to the random ticket draw winner.**

**The draw winner is not required to be present to win the draw prize of 20% or the accumulated jackpot.**

**The draw winner will be announced verbally, as well as displayed visually to those in attendance.**

**The draw winner is awarded the chance to win the accumulated jackpot by choosing a card from the deck of cards.**

**If the winner is unable to attend, the Proxy appointed that evening will choose a card from the deck on behalf of the winner.**

**Winner will be awarded their prize in the form of a cheque.**

**Both the drawing of the ticket and the choosing of the card from the deck will be recorded and kept for audit purposes.**
